

Chagford Jubilee Hall Protection of Children and Age Verification Policy

This policy applies in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol at The Jubilee Hall,
Chagford TQ13 8DP

Premises licence holder: Jubilee Hall Committee
Designated premises supervisor (DPS): Andrew Kent

1. For this policy the Responsible Person is one of the following:
 - The designated premises supervisor;
 - A person who is authorised to allow the sale or supply of alcohol by the DPS;
 - A person who holds a Temporary Event Notice or a personal licence to sell alcohol.
2. The Responsible Person will ensure that staff are made aware of the existence and content of this policy.
3. Parents or guardians must take full responsibility for the behaviour of their children whilst on the premises and must abide by any conditions set by the trustees of the Jubilee Hall.
4. All children under the age of 16 years are to be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
5. Children under the age of 16 years must not approach the bar at any time.
6. No alcohol is to be consumed by or purchased by, for, or on behalf of anyone under the age of 18 years.
7. In the case of doubt as to a person's age the Responsible Person or his or her authorised representative must require photographic proof of age. If proof of age cannot be provided, then the person must not be served any alcoholic drink
8. Examples of appropriate identification include:
 - passport
 - photo card driving licence
 - proof of age card bearing the PASS hologram
 - military identification card.
